Greetings to the many Nehrenz family members and friends all across the U.S.A.!

This newsletter will introduce you to the family of **Christian Nehrenz**, the second oldest son of Johann Christian Nehrenz. To refresh your Nehrenz history knowledge, here are the original Nehrenz people who came from Trollehagen, Germany in November 1869 to the Battery Park Castle Garden on Manhattan Island in New York City and then to Cleveland, Ohio:

Christian was the second oldest son, and he was 23 years old when he came to America on the ship "Borussia" in 1869 with his parents and younger siblings. It is worth noting that the oldest son Frederick and the third oldest son Carl did not come to America till 1871. Thus Christian was the oldest son present with his parents in 1869, and the first one to get a job and begin to make a place for himself in their new country.

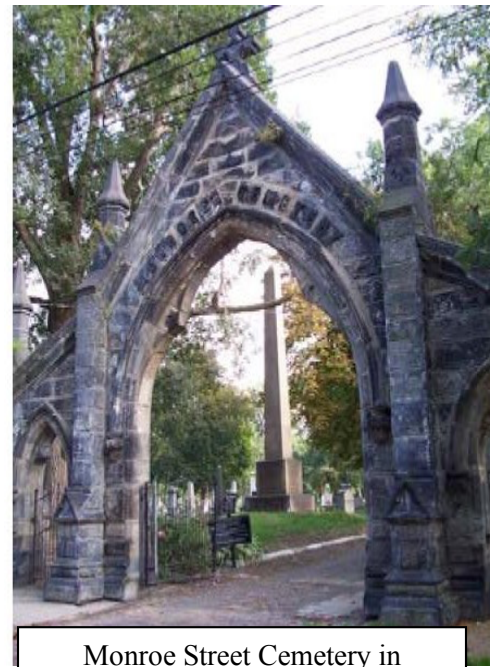
He was a construction worker / laborer and brick mason. He married Freiderika "Rike" Bahlhe in 1874 and they had 10 children. We only know details about four of their children: Louise Nehrenz Schnur, Charles Nehrenz, Bertha Nehrenz Schaloske and Minnie Nehrenz. We do not have any photographs of Christian and Freiderika Nehrenz. Included in this newsletter are some of the details about this family.

You will be reminded of the difficult struggles for these immigrants in a new land. They attended the Lutheran church, worked hard and raised their children. Most all of the Nehrenz families lived in the same Cleveland, Ohio neighborhoods. It is because of their sacrifices that we, their descendants, are living in a free and prosperous nation!

HISTORICAL INFORMATION

Johann "Christian" Nehrenz emigrated from Germany, leaving from Hamburg Germany on Oct. 30, 1869. He was a farmer in Trollenhagen (Mecklenburg Strelitz) Germany. He was 49, his wife Maria was 50, sons: **Christian- 23**, Wilhelm- 12, Henry- 7, daughters: Wilhelmine- 18, Johanna-9.

They sailed on the ship "S.S. Borussia" (1855 Hamburg-American Line) and arrived in New York on Nov. 19, 1869.

(His eldest son Friedrich came over two years later in 1871 with his wife Friedrika and brother Carl)

"**CHRISTIAN**" -**JOHANN CHRISTIAN FRIEDRICK NEHRENZ** was born April 07, 1846 in Trollenhagen, Germany, and died October 14, 1916 in Cleveland, Ohio. He married **FREIDERIKA "RIKE" BAHLE** (?Bahlke?) August 07, 1874 in Trinity Lutheran Church Cleveland, Ohio - Officiant: Pastor H. Wynekin, minister. She was the daughter of MR. BAHLE. She was born 1850 in Neddemin Mecklenberg Strelitz, Germany, and died February 19, 1893 in Cleveland, Ohio.

Note: **Christian** came to the USA with his parents in Nov. 1869, his daughter Louise was born in Germany in 1870, yet he and Friederike were not married till 1874 in the U.S. It is 1873 when Louise actually came to the U.S. with her mother Freidrika. Perhaps Christian and Freidrika were already married in Germany, he came here first, then his wife and his daughter came later and they also had a wedding in Ohio?

Christian and Freidrika are buried in an unmarked grave in the Monroe Cemetery in Cleveland, OH at the site of U-4-25 in between Christian Huges and Carl and Marie Just. At the time their address was 39 Kinkel St. when Friederika died. He was burial person no. 25481 and was buried on top of his wife. Reference number in the book was #26825.

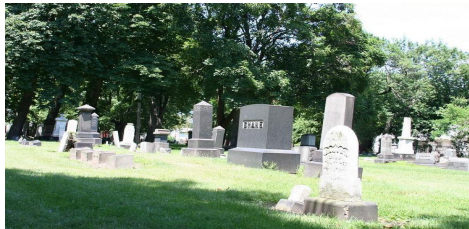

the Two Sons of Charles Nehrenz:**

FLOYD W. NEHRENZ¹, b. July 05, 1903, Ohio; d. November 25, 1996, San Diego, California.

"In 1998, David Nehrenz was contacted by Steven Kingston (800-959-9335) from 4011 Calle Abril San Clemente, CA. 92673 an "heir hunter" who befriended Floyd in a coffee shop and nursing home. Floyd was a loner, never married and he moved to CA. after WW II. Then Isabelle Pusey was put in contact with Mr. Kingston who settled Floyd's estate and send a portion of it to the Pusey family, since they were the only known closest relatives. A sad story about a lonely man, and a glimpse at how these "heir-hunters" work for a percentage of the estate of old people without any heirs. This Mr. Kingston does this work as a profession by going to court to settle the estates of heirless people."

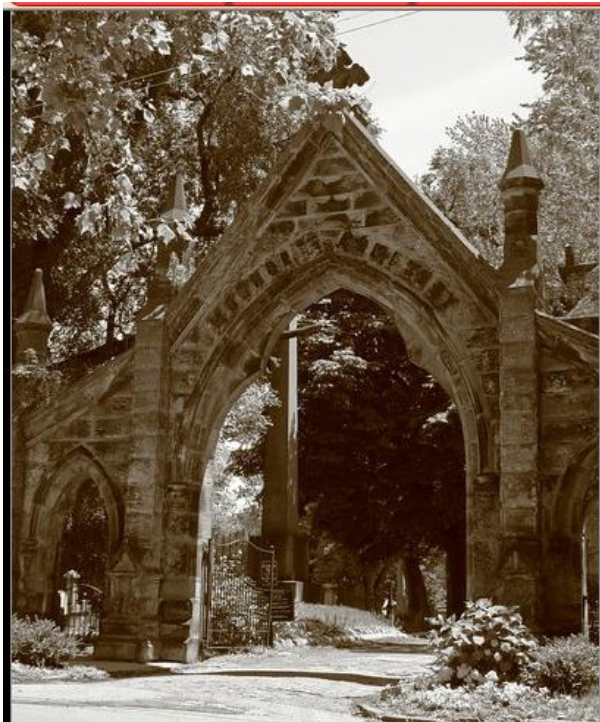

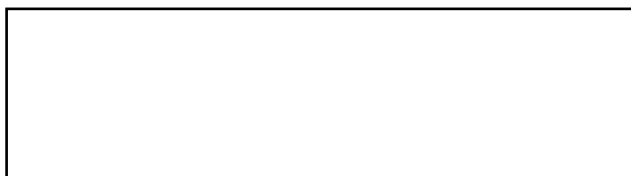
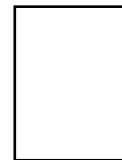
